The Village of Salado, Texas is a lovely historic town nestled in the central Texas Hill Country. With many bed & breakfasts, wineries, and over 60 shops and art galleries, it has become a popular destination for visitors worldwide.

Keep Salado Beautiful (KSB) is an official all-volunteer council serving the needs of the Village. Its mission is to educate and engage Salado citizens to take responsibility for improving their community environment. KSB began as a city resolution passed in 2008 and in 2009 received official affiliation from the Keep Texas Beautiful campaign.

Salado Gardens is a creative collaboration between KSB, Master Naturalists and Master Gardeners and local businesses to create new “pocket gardens” or renovate existing gardens throughout beautiful, low maintenance, and drought-tolerant.

To educate visitors about each unique garden and about the Salado Gardens project, KSB harnessed the creativity of Salado’s High School students to design original sign-art for each garden.
